### ***PERMANENT EARLY VOTING LIST INFORMATION***

Pima County Recorder, F. Ann Rodriguez announced today that approximately 120,000 Pima County voters have already signed up to be included on the Permanent Early Voting List (PEVL), or over 25% of Pima County's 478,000 voters. "The voters' response to this opportunity has been overwhelming," stated Ms. Rodriguez. This means that every voter on the PEVL will automatically get a ballot by mail for every election they are eligible for, in all jurisdictions in Pima County.

"The Recorder's office will mail out notices twice a year notifying voters of any elections coming up. If a voter does not want to receive a ballot by mail for that particular election, they can indicate that on the notice and mail it back to us," stated Ms. Rodriguez. "Voters will be given the opportunity to 'opt out' of receiving a ballot by mail for any election." Opting out of any election does not cancel the voter from the PEVL list. The notice will also give independent voters, or voters with no party designation, the chance to select the political party ballot they would like to vote in partisan elections.

Voters who have not yet signed up to be included in the PEVL may do so at any time. A form is now available on the Recorder's web site at [www.recorder.pima.gov](http://www.recorder.pima.gov). This form may be downloaded, printed, completed and mailed in to the Pima County Recorder's office.
