ONLY 4 MORE DAYS TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE ELECTION!

Make sure that you will be eligible to vote in this Historic Election!!

***Record numbers of voters have been registering since we kicked off this
reminder notice. Make sure your voice is heard!!!***

Pima County Recorder F. Ann Rodriguez would like to remind voters there are only **FOUR (4)** more days to register or re-register, to be eligible to vote in the February 5, 2008 Presidential Preference Election (PPE). Anyone wishing to participate in this election **must** be registered with the same political party affiliation of the Presidential candidate they wish to vote for (either Democratic or Republican), in accordance with A.R.S. §16-241(A). The deadline to register is **MIDNIGHT ON MONDAY, JANUARY 7, 2008.**

Re-registering can be done simply by completing a new voter registration form. Voters with an Arizona driver's license or Motor Vehicle Division (MVD) identification card issued after October 1, 1996 may register online at the MVD voter registration site at www.servicearizona.com. In addition, forms may be obtained at the Pima County Recorder's offices at **115 North Church Avenue in the Historic Old Courthouse building**, and at the **eastside location at 6920 East Broadway, Suite D in the Gaslight Theater Complex**. Forms may also be obtained at any Arizona Department of Motor Vehicle branch, all post offices and libraries, political party headquarters, and city/town halls and City Ward offices. Voters may also log onto the Recorder's office web site at
