VOTER REGISTRATION RECEIVED FROM NEW CITIZENSHIP SWEARING-IN CEREMONY

Pima County Recorder F. Ann Rodriguez announced that the Pima County Recorder's office, along with employees from 17 other Pima County departments, registered 1,056 new United States citizens at the new citizenship swearing-in ceremony held at the Tucson Community Center today. Other Pima County departments that participated are: Assessor's Office, Community Services, Constable, County Administrator, County Attorney, Development Services, Facilities Management, Finance, Graphic Services, Medial Examiner, Office of Court Appointed Counsel, Pima County Library, Posada del Sol, Procurement, Public Works Administration, Superior Court, and Telecom Services. Ms. Rodriguez is very grateful for the assistance given by these other County departments.

"This was a joyous occasion for these new citizens," stated Ms. Rodriguez. "One of their first activities as a new American was to register to vote, so that they can participate in the November 4th Presidential election. Many of these new citizens are very eager to participate in the democratic process in November."

Citizens who reside in Santa Cruz, Cochise, Pinal, Graham and Maricopa counties, in addition to Pima County were registered by the Pima County Recorder's office.
