Pima County Recorder F. Ann Rodriguez wishes to remind voters that the cut-off to register to vote for the following November 6, 2007 consolidated elections is **MONDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2007:**

City of Tucson General
Amphitheater Unified School District Bond
Sahuarita Unified School District Override and Bond
Altar Valley Elementary School District Maintenance & Operations Budget Override
Picture Rocks Fire District Bond
Rincon Valley Fire District Bond

A new voter registration form must be completed by anyone who has moved (even to a new apartment number in the same complex) or changed their name since their last registration. New Pima County residents will have to follow the requirements of Prop 200; information on these requirements may be found on the back of the voter registration form, or on the Recorder's office web site at www.recorder.pima.gov. Forms may be obtained at the Pima County Recorder's office, any Arizona Department of Motor Vehicle branch, all post offices and libraries, political party headquarters, and city/town halls, or by logging on to the Recorder's office web site at www.recorder.pima.gov and either downloading a form to complete and mail in, or clicking on the link to the on-line version of EZ Voter.
