## ***2018-GENERAL ELECTION NUMBERS*** ***Breakdown from Recorder's Office***

The 2018-General Election broke many voting records in Pima County. Pima County's number of registered voters grew to a record **557,532**. We also had the highest Voter participation for a Mid-Term election in our County's history and rivaled the 2016-General Election numbers. Pima County Recorder, F. Ann Rodriguez stated, "This election year has kept our office extremely busy. The voter registration numbers are great but what's really exciting is the increased number of registered voters who voted in this election. That means more people actually participated in the election process!"

Our office has had a lot of interest this year in the number of voters, their ages, their party affiliations and the breakdown of Early Voting vs. Polling Location voting. Below is a breakdown of those numbers.
