### *MAIL IN YOUR BALLOT BY MAIL BY WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 30<sup>th</sup>*

The Pima County 2019-Jurisdictional Election is an all Ballot by Mail election. All Pima County residents registered to vote and living within the districts holding elections received a Ballot by Mail.

The districts included in the Pima County 2019-Jurisdictional Election are: Altar Valley School, Amphi School, Flowing Wells School, Sunnyside School and Golder Ranch Fire.

Ballot by Mail and Replacement voting in Pima County has been underway for almost three weeks. F. Ann Rodriguez, the Pima County Recorder would like to remind everyone, "The suggested time to mail in your Ballot by Mail is this **Wednesday, October 30, 2019.**"

You have **THREE** options when returning your Ballot by Mail:

- 1) **MAIL IT:** We recommend you mail your Ballot by Mail on or before Wednesday, October 30<sup>th</sup> to ensure your ballot reaches our office by Election Day.
- 2) **REPLACEMENT BALLOT SITES:** Drop off your Ballot by Mail at any of our Replacement Ballot Locations. For a list of Replacement Ballot locations and hours of operation visit [www.recorder.pima.gov](http://www.recorder.pima.gov) and click on Early Voting Sites. Three walk-in sites will be open 8 a.m. - 5 p.m., Monday, October 28, 2019 through Friday, November 1, 2019 as well as on Monday, November 4, 2019.
- 3) **ELECTION DAY:** Drop off your Ballot by Mail or request a replacement ballot at any Pima County Replacement Ballot Site on **Election Day-Tuesday, November 5, 2019** between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 7 p.m.
